Other information: ENTERED ON 26 FEBRUARY 1918 AND SENT TO CAMP DODGE IOWA. ON 23 MARCH 1918, HE WAS TRANSFERRED TO CAMP GRANT AND ASSIGNED TO COMPANY B, 311th ENGINEERS. LEFT FOR FRANCE ON 14 JUNE 1918 AND STATIONED AT BORDEAUX AND MARSEILLES. BECAME SICK WITH PNEUMONIA AND 14 MAY 1919 AND WAS PUT IN BASE HOSPITAL 65 AT KERHUON. DIED OF BRONCHO-PNEUMONIA WITH INFLAMMATION OF THE HEART. BURIED AT AMERICAN EXPEDITIONARY FORCE CEMETARY IN FRANCE.
