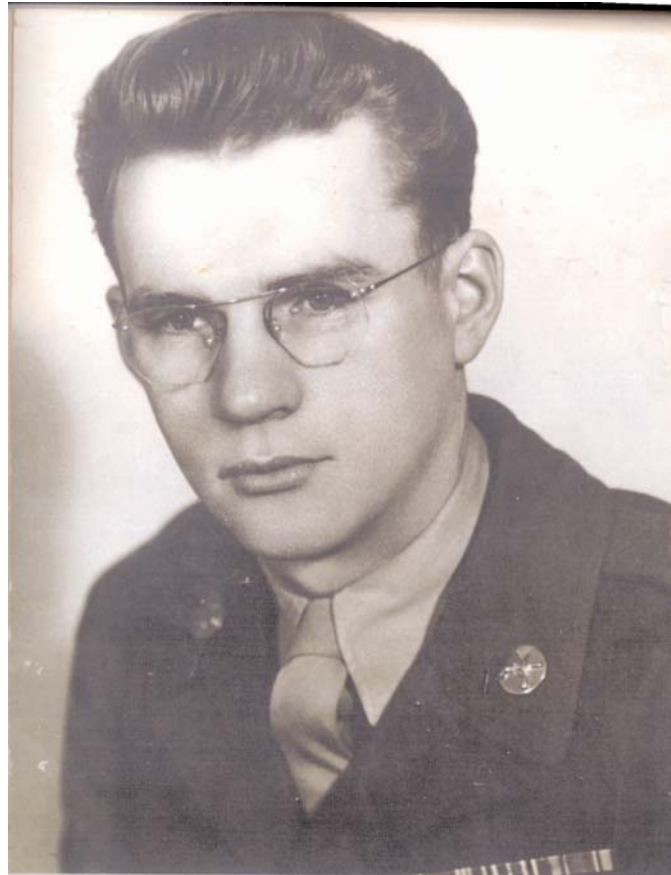
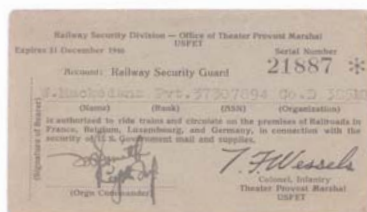


Warren Mackedanz



Warren Mackedanz (37307894) entered the US Army on 14 September 1942 at Fort Snelling in Minnesota. After training he was sent to the Panama Canal Zone on 31 January 1943, arriving on 8 February. On 3 April 1944 he started training for 060 Cook School while at the Canal Zone. This training was for 8 weeks. On 11 February 1945 Warren left Panama for California arriving on 22 February. He was discharged as a Private First Class on 26 September 1945 at Fort Jackson South Carolina. He wanted to go overseas and had to retrain for a different job. For this he needed to be discharged and re-enlist. Warren Re-enlisted on 27 September 1945 and became an MP, Military Policeman. On 6 May 1946 he left the United States for the European Theater arriving on 10 May. He was stationed in the Army of Occupation in Germany and other parts of Europe as a Military Policeman. On 24 January 1947 he left Europe for the United States. He arrived in the US on 1 February 1947 and was discharged from Company D, 385 MP Battalion on 20 February 1947.
